

The Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences of the University of Fribourg (Switzerland) invites applications for a full-time professor position starting September 1, 2017

Associate Professor in Strategic Entrepreneurship/ Innovation/SME Management

Applicants must have teaching and research experience in the relevant fields. They should have demonstrated their ability to publish regularly in high-quality peer-reviewed journals. The candidate's specialization should relate to the core topics in the field. The successful candidate will be in charge of teaching courses in French at the Bachelor (e.g., Introduction to Management) and at the Master-level. The Master courses should be, e.g., about Strategic Entrepreneurship, Innovation management, SME management as well as about international aspects of SMEs. Course contents should be coordinated with the current offer of the faculty. Part of the Master courses must be in English.

As the University of Fribourg is a bilingual institution (French/German), fluency in French is required and passive knowledge of German is expected in the medium-term.

The successful candidate must have a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) in the field, a high-quality publication record, and relevant teaching experience. Experience in cooperative research with companies is an additional asset. The University offers an excellent work environment and a highly competitive salary in international comparison.
